Welcome back to Term 4! We hope you all had a wonderful break!

This term our English will be based around the traditional tales of Little Red Riding Hood and the Three Billy Goats Gruff, where we will be listening to the traditional telling of the story as well as those with a twist. We will use these retellings to inspire our own story writing. To further our learning, we will be going on a trip to Bexhill library on Thursday 6th of March where we will find out about how the library works, listen to traditional tales and if your child has a library card, they will be welcome to select a book to take out. More details will follow shortly.

In Maths, we will be exploring the concept of composition of numbers, including tens and ones in two digit numbers to twenty.

In our writing, we will continue to strengthen our knowledge and independent use of digraphs and trigraphs (two or three letters that make one sound). We will also be developing our use of capital letters and full stops within sentences.
