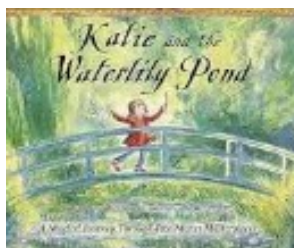

Focus: To use colour, pattern and texture, line, shape, form and space.

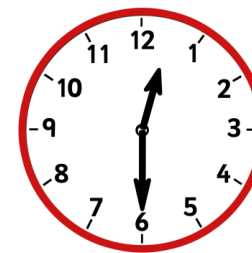
Artists: Claude Monet & Andy Warhol

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Design and Technology

Aspect of DT: Food

Focus: Preparing fruit & vegetables

The children will be designing, making and evaluating fruit kebabs. They will also discuss the importance of healthy living and eating a balanced meal.



Religious Education

Focus: Christianity

Key Question: What is the 'good news' Christians believe Jesus brings?



The children will be learning about the Christian faith through looking at the idea of Gospel. The Gospel stories are the stories of Jesus' life and they are found in the New Testament of the Bible.

Music

Focus: Digging the Garden



The children will be focusing on aspects of singing, playing, improvising, composing, and listening.

Play the instruments in sequential order whilst others act out the steps simultaneously.

Computing

Focus: Creating media - Digital music

The children will be exploring how music can make them think and feel. They will be creating different rhythms and tunes, using the movement of animals for inspiration.



Science

Focus: Plants

Key Question: How do seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants?

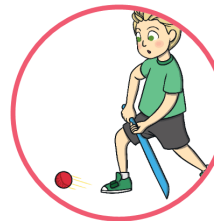
This term we will use the local environment to observe how plants grow. We will look at the requirements of plants for germination, growth and survival, as well as the process of reproduction and growth in plants.



Physical Education

Focus: Striking and Fielding

Skills: We are developing our striking technique to show control when hitting a travelling object. We will practice our throwing and catching techniques to allow us to consider different throws depending on the distance we are sending an object.

Focus: Healthy Body & Healthy Mind
